



Merger of Stratus Packaging and JPL

On 1 June 2014, the Stratus Packaging Group took over the JPL Etiquette and JPL Log Companies, combining them into one of Stratus Packaging Holdings' new subsidiaries called "Stratus Health and Beauty".

This acquisition should assist the Stratus Packaging Group in continuing its expansion in the field of adhesive labels as well as the specialisation of its sites in order to provide its customers with products and services tailored to their specific needs.

It also allows Stratus Packaging, one of France's leaders in the offset digital labelling field, to enhance its digital offering as a result of the addition of inkjet equipment used at JPL. Combined screen printing/flexo printing will be added to Stratus Packaging's range of products and services. New services, such as 100% print quality control, can now be offered to all of the Group's customers, enabling the Stratus Packaging and JPL Groups to make available to their customers an even more comprehensive global offering.

The new Group will have over 270 employees located at 5 production sites, managing more than 40 production lines.
